Dear Parents/Guardians,

Happy New Year and welcome back.

It has been an incredibly busy start to the 3rd Term with every year group and subject area getting off to a great start. Two subjects that I would like to mention specifically are firstly Science, where I have seen evidence of kidney dissections, anatomical drawings, chemical experiments involving reflection, refraction, and light ray boxes, the manufacture of pinhole cameras and DNA models involving the mass of carbon dioxide using carbonated drinks and candy. Secondly, in Music, our students are working on several festive pieces of music, whilst preparing for the Chinese New Year celebrations which involves some routines that will be performed in public in the coming weeks.


