Foundation Course in English

Course Objectives

- Expand their vocabulary to include common words and phrases used in everyday situations
- Speak and listen with greater confidence and fluency
- Read and comprehend basic texts, such as signs, advertisements, and short articles
- Write simple sentences and paragraphs, including emails, short letters, and forms
- Understand the cultural context of the English language and apply this knowledge to communication

Pre-requisites

No prior knowledge of English is required for this course. However, learners should have a basic level of literacy in their first language, and be prepared to dedicate time outside of class to review and practice what they have learned.

- Minimum Attainment of A1 or A2 in CEPT (benchmarked at IELTS Score 0 3.5)
- Completion of 6 years of education or equivalent

Intermediate Course in English

Course Objectives

By the end of the course, learners will be able to:

- Use more complex grammar structures, including conditional sentences, reported speech, and passive voice
- Expand their vocabulary to include a range of topics and contexts, including work, travel, and current events
- Speak and listen with greater accuracy and fluency, including in more complex conversations and debates
- Read and comprehend longer and more complex texts, including news articles, short stories, and academic texts
- Write more complex sentences and paragraphs, including essays, reports, and formal letters
- Understand and analyze the cultural context of the English language, including its use in literature and media

Pre-requisites

Learners should have a basic understanding of English grammar and vocabulary, and be able to communicate in everyday situations. It is recommended that learners have completed a basic English course before taking this intermediate course.

Admission Requirements

- Minimum 12 years of age
- Minimum Attainment of B1 or B2 in CEPT (benchmarked at IELTS Score 4.0 6.5)
- Completion of 7 years of education or equivalent

Advanced Course in English

Course Objectives

By the end of the course, learners will be able to:

- Use advanced grammar structures with accuracy and precision
- Communicate effectively in academic and professional settings, including giving presentations, participating in discussions, and writing research papers
- Analyze and evaluate complex English-language texts, including literature, academic articles, and news media
- Expand their vocabulary to include advanced academic and professional terminology

- Write complex and coherent arguments and essays
- Understand and analyze the cultural context of the English language, including its use in literature, media, and society

Pre-requisites

Learners should have a high level of proficiency in English grammar, vocabulary, and communication skills. It is recommended that learners have completed an intermediate English course before taking this course.

Admission Requirements

- Minimum 12 years of age
- Minimum Attainment of C1 or C2 in CEPT (benchmarked at IELTS Score 7.0 9.0)
- Completion of 8 years of education or equivalent

Admission Pre-requisites

Applicants must:

- Be above 12 years of age as of 1st January of the year of enrolment
- Sit for a placement test to determine a suitable tier for them

Note: Students who are unable to meet the pre-requisite admission criteria would need the approval from the school's Principal prior to admission.

A. Refund for Withdrawal Due To Non-Delivery of Course

Invictus will notify the parent within three (3) working days upon knowledge of any of the following:

- i) It does not commence the Course on the Course Commencement Date;
- ii) It terminates the Course before the Course Commencement Date;
- iii) It does not complete the Course by the Course Completion Date;
- iv) It terminates the Course before the Course Completion Date;
- v) It has not ensured that the Student meets the course entry or matriculation requirement as set by the organisation stated in Schedule A (of the Student Contract) within any stipulated timeline set by CPE;
- vi) The Student's Pass application is rejected by the Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA).

The parent/student should be informed in writing of alternative study arrangements (if any). Upon receiving the School's notification, the Student may withdraw from the Course by submitting a written notice of withdrawal, in which case the Student will be entitled to a refund of all Course Fees and the Miscellaneous Fees already paid.

However, in the case of a withdrawal arising from (vi) the Student's Pass application is rejected by the Immigration and Checkpoints Authority of Singapore (ICA), the Course Fees and the Miscellaneous Fees already paid shall be refunded.

Such refund will be made within seven (7) working days of the School receiving the signed Withdrawal Form.

B. Refund for Withdrawal For Other Reasons

If the Student withdraws from the Course for any reason other than those stated in Clause 2.1, of the standard student contract version 3.1, Invictus will, within seven (7) working days of, Withdrawal Form signed date, refund to the Student an amount based on the table in Schedule D of that contract.

C. Refund During Cooling-Off Period

Invictus will provide the parent/student with a cooling-off period of seven (7) working days after the date that the Contract has been signed by both parties.

The parent/student will be refunded the highest percentage (stated in Schedule D) of the fees already paid if the parent submits a written notice of withdrawal to Invictus within the cooling-off period, regardless of whether the student has started the course or not.

Admission Procedures

Step 1: Presentation of Course Information and Pre-Course Counselling

Applicants will be presented with the following information:

- Course Information
- Course Pre-requisites
- Course Admission Requirements

A Pre-course counselling session will be conducted with the applicant for them to find out more about studying with Invictus International School and a list of important information will be presented to them.

Step 2: Placement Test

Invictus will arrange for the applicant to sit for a Placement Test to determine the suitable course level and duration for the applicant.

Step 3: Submission of Application Forms

Applicants enrolling for the Invictus' course will have to submit the following items in person or via email: For Local Students (Singapore Citizen and Permanent Resident)

- Completed Application Form with Application Fee and obtained prior approval from MOE (for Singaporean only)
- Supporting Documents:
 - NRIC and Passport
 - Highest Qualification Certificate and Transcripts

For International Students

- Completed Application Form with Application Fee
- Supporting Documents Required for Student's Pass Application
 - Please refer to the following section "Important Information for International Students" for the list of documents required for Student's Pass application
- Processing and Approval of Student's Pass
 - For International Students, processing and approval of the Student's Pass by ICA will take 4-6 weeks after submission of application. Invictus will notify the student with the In-Principal Approval (IPA) letter from ICA once the Student's Pass application is approved. The school will also arrange with the student to collect their Student's Pass.
- Medical Check-up
 - Students may be required to undergo a Medical Check-up in Singapore under the advice of ICA. Results of the medical check-up can be obtained within 3 5 days.

For International Students, Invictus can only provide assistance to submit the Student's Pass application, and that the granting of student's pass is subject to ICA's approval.

Step 4: Acceptance of Course and Payment

Applicants will be issued with the Letter of Offer by Invictus and they accept the offer through the submission of the signed Standard Student Contract and Advisory Note. Payment of the course fees will also be made. Items to submit to Invictus include:

- Advisory Note
- Standard Student Contract
- Course fees payment according to Course Fees Notice

The original supporting documents should be submitted to the school for verification checks when student reports to school. If the originals differ from the scanned copies, the school fully reserves the right to rescind the Letter of Offer and terminate the Student Contract.

Invictus will hold an orientation programme for students before their course commences and introduce them to the school and its policies, rules and regulations. Critical course information will be reiterated to the students again. International students can also get acquainted with Singapore's culture and customs.

2. Immigration and Checkpoints Authority (ICA) Regulations

All students with a Student's Pass are to meet all the following requirements:

- 1) A student holding Student's Pass must attend a minimum of 90% of scheduled course hours and not be absent from the course for 7 consecutive days.
- 2) A student must not engage in any form of activities that may contravene the stipulated "Terms & Conditions of Student's Pass (STP)" (including those stated In the Student's Pass application form, In-Principle Approval letter and Student's Pass Card) upon which a Student's Pass is issued. The student is not permitted to engage in any form of employment or attend an industrial attachment/internship programme, whether paid or unpaid, without a valid work pass issued by Ministry of Manpower.
- 3) A student must not remain in Singapore without proper authority after the expiry of the Student's Pass. The school will inform the ICA of his/her means and date of departure.
- 4) A student is permitted to attend the course only after the approval of the Student's Pass has been given by the ICA.
- 5) A student must not be retained as a student in any other school(s) or course(s) other than the one indicated in the Student's Pass application form.
- 6) A student must surrender the Student's Pass for cancellation within seven days from the date if cessation or termination of his/her studies or course(s).
